

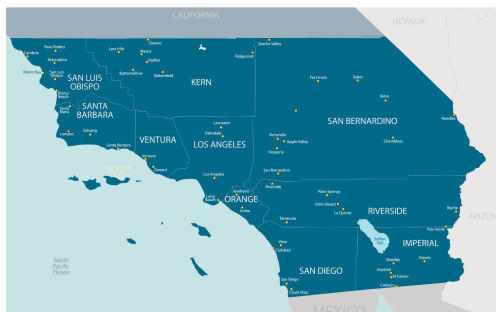
Fair Pay for Southern California Nonprofits: The 2023 Compensation & Benefits Survey

Low unemployment, increased inflation and softening demand in some sectors of the economy are creating uncertain conditions for nonprofit managers as they make decisions about employee compensation and benefits policies. Here's how your organization will benefit from the 2023 survey report:
