

# Fair Pay for Southern California Nonprofits: The 2026 Compensation & Benefits Survey



**Participation Deadline:** March 6, 2026 (extended deadline)  
**Report Publication:** April 30, 2026

California’s nonprofit sector, which employs around 10% of the state’s workforce and provides vital services to communities throughout the state, is impacted by continuing inflation, uncertainty around funding sources, concern about softening economic conditions, and shifting federal government policies. In this environment, the 2026 survey report will provide information not available anywhere else to nonprofit leaders responsible for their organizations’ compensation and benefits policies:

- Current, local compensation data on more than 200 jobs found in nonprofit organizations throughout Southern California
- Base pay levels and bonus/incentive pay for each job with details by annual operating budget, location within Southern California, number of employees and primary field of service
- Employee benefits in detail: paid time off, insurance, retirement
- Salary increases over the past year and expected during the next year
- Policies with respect to on-call work, overtime, shift differentials, pay for bilingual skills, introductory periods, performance reviews and more
- Impacts of the current economic and political environment on operations and policies



The survey serves all kinds of nonprofits in the ten Southern California counties of **Imperial, Kern, Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, San Diego, San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara and Ventura**. We make special efforts to serve both larger and smaller nonprofit organizations, as well as those from both urban/suburban and rural counties.
